Sarah Atlee's geometric abstractions in paint, paper and fabric are infused with the play between spontaneity and perfection. "I am increasingly influenced by modern quiltmaking, balancing the dual impulses of precision and improvisation — making perfect versus making do." She explores the pure pleasure of placing color next to color, building a composition one stroke (or stitch) at a time, and honoring artisans of the past and present by building on tradition.



Let's make a quilt together! You bring the fabric, I'll do the sewing.



Fabric Information -

SIZE: BETWEEN 3x3 and 12x12 inches. No larger or smaller.

NUMBER OF PIECES: 1 or 2. (No more, please, I'm at fabric

storage capacity!)

SHAPE: Any shape, as long as it meets the SIZE limits.

Squares, rectangles, strips, and irregular swatches are all okay.

I will be cutting into it.

FABRIC: 100% Cotton. If you're not sure, then thanks but no thanks. No t-shirts. Denim is okay if it's not too thick or starchy. PLEASE NO: Buttons, zippers, pockets, beads, knitting, crochet, heavy embroidery, etc. For this project, they will only be in the way.

COLOR: Any color, solid, print, stripes, busy, quiet, bright, dark, old, new, whatever, as long as it's 100% cotton.

Contributing fabric is OPTIONAL. I'll be bringing fabric too.
